“WHAT SIZE SHOULD I GET?”

One of the most common questions we get when it comes to the Big Duck is choosing the right size.

It's not always an easy decision. When people are comparing the different sizes (the 2.3m, 2.9m, and 3.3m) the same questions come up time and time again: Will my family of four fit comfortably? Would the missus prefer something smaller or a bit bigger? Will there be enough room for the boys and the cooler? And will it actually fit in the caravan for our next camping trip?

We hear these questions daily, so we thought it was time to break it down and make the choice a whole lot easier.



The 2.3m is the smallest in the range and is all about simplicity and portability. It's perfect for solo trips or heading out with one other person. If you're after something lightweight, easy to carry, and quick to set up, the 2.3m is a great option. It's especially popular for solo fishing runs, tender use, or when storage space is tight.



Stepping up, the 2.9m offers a bit more room while still being easy to manage. It's a great middle-ground option — ideal for couples or families of three who want something compact but with a little extra space to move. It's a very popular option for couples who love their weekend adventures, whether that's exploring, camping trips, or time on the water, and it still packs down well for transport or caravan storage.



At the top end, the 3.3m gives you the most space and versatility. It's the go-to choice for families, friend groups, or anyone planning longer days on the water. With two benches and more room for people, gear, and an esky, it offers a more comfortable and relaxed experience overall. For a family of four, this is usually the best fit.

So, which one would you choose?

If you want something ultra-light and compact → the 2.3m is your go-to.

If you're after a balance between size and practicality → the 2.9m does it well.

If space, comfort, and flexibility matter most → the 3.3m is hard to beat.

Regardless, all three of our dinghies are easy to store and compact, and they fit neatly into the carry bag provided when you purchase a Big Duck.

If you're still on the fence, our honest advice is simple — most people never regret going a little bigger. That extra space can make a big difference once you're out on the water with family, mates, and all the gear that comes with it.
